



COVID-19 Safety Plan

Keeping People Safe

This plan will be shared with and emailed to those working/using in the facility. On the person's next visit to the facility a review of changes and ensure understanding will be given verbally.

Customers Entering the Facility and Outside Events

All participants on arrival will be asked to take part in the online screening tool. This will be administered by TailWaggersK9Sport and will include anybody opting to wait outside the facility. This will be undertaken before getting out of the vehicle at a distance 2 meters away.

Minimizing Transmission

Numbers entering the facility will be limited to 4 people, 1 handler per dog and the instructor.

Visual spacing of 2 metres is shown on the walls.

We will use the outdoor space as much as possible.

Before entering the facility for new classes, new privates and when there is a change in the procedure - we will gather (with 2m distance) outside and understand the requirements before entering.

Everyone is asked to minimize touching any surface.

All participants are asked to use the hand sanitizer on entrance to the building.

Commonly used surfaces are wiped down between classes/sessions.

No young children are permitted (under the age of 12yrs), those between 12-18yr are permitted in private sessions but with strict instructions that they are involved in the training and not watching (this avoids the need to touch things).

All commonly used surfaces and any additional surfaces or equipment used in class will be wiped down post class, prior to the next class. This includes but is not limited to, doors and door handles.

Potential Case or Exposure to Covid-19 at the Facility

A potential case is viewed as someone that would fail the screening checklist. A confirmed case is viewed as someone who has undergone testing and has positive result.

Potential Case

If identified during the screening, the person will be asked to leave the facility and to follow the guidelines set out by the Renfrew County & District Health Unit (RCDHU).

Confirmed Case

If a person discovers they have Covid-19 and have already attended a class/session.

All training at the facility will be suspended, the RCDHU will be contacted for further advice.

All people who have attended since said person, will be contacted.

Managing the Changes

Customers will be emailed before hand with all updates. In addition the safety plan will appear on our website and be posted on the walls of the facility.

Changes and practices will be briefed at the start of each session.

Plan Updates

This plan will be reviewed, as the pandemic progresses. New suggestions are welcome and will be incorporated as necessary. Changes will be shared with customers and volunteers via email and at the initial visit.
